New Web Portal Coming This Summer!

We are pleased to announce that we will be launching a new web portal for students, parents and teachers this summer. The new solution is called PlusPortals and will replace our current Edline service in early July. This portal will provide access to resources for classes, schedules, grades and other specific information for students and parents.

Grades for the 2016-2017 school year will be posted to Edline at their scheduled time in June. Access to Edline will end on June 30. Student schedules for the 2017-2018 school year will be posted on the new PlusPortals in July.

Students and parents will receive credentials to access the new PlusPortals via email in late June. Each student and parent/guardian will receive an email to activate their PlusPortals account. These emails will be sent from messenger@plusportals.com and will have a subject line titled: "**Saint Ignatius PlusPortals Account Activation Details for Parents and Students - ACTION REQUIRED.**"
