- **You will need to be registered for tryouts by August 15th to participate - please don't wait until the last minute to complete waivers, medical forms, etc.**

**Team Overview:** Sailors earn Varsity and JV recognition, and our team is part of the school's athletic department, but we are not funded by the school and sailing is not an IHSA-sanctioned sport. The team is managed by parent volunteers, but coaching and facilities are provided by Chicago Yacht Club. We practice together with a few other area schools.

**Tryouts/Squads:** We would like to be able to share our sport with everyone who walks on, but we have limited capacity, and some years need to make cuts. Coaches may place students in one of three levels: Varsity, Junior Varsity, and Frosh/Soph, which may also include some upper class new to sailing. Tryouts on August 23rd for new sailors or those wanting to move up a squad. You must sign up by August 15th and have your paperwork in.

**Practice Location:** Chicago Yacht Club - Belmont Harbor, Belmont and Lake Shore Drive

**Transportation:** The team captains arrange carpools or their own rides to and from practices. Usually, there are enough student drivers to cover the need,

but depending on team size, parents may need to pitch in.

- Practice Schedule: Weekday practices are after school until 7pm.  
Tuesday - All (JV and Varsity in 420s, Fresh/Soph in Sonars or 420s)  
Wednesday - Varsity Only  
Thursday - All (JV and Varsity in 420s, Fresh/Soph in Sonars or 420s)  
Friday Varsity Only (Team Race Regattas)  
Saturday 9-4 p.m. - Fresh/Soph and JV in 420s  
(Some Friday/Saturday practices will be pre-empted by team regattas)
- Regattas: Most competitions are weekend-long events. For Chicago-area regattas, sailors arrange their own transportation each day. Travel to out-of-town events will be coordinated with parent chaperones/drivers. Housing is often provided by families of host teams. When it is not, we stay in hotels. The coaches usually announce rosters a week and a half in advance.

- Gear: Life jacket, close-toed shoes or sailing boots, fleece/sweatshirt, foul weather gear/spray top/windbreaker, gloves/hat.  
Dry suit required for spring season.  
Team discounts available at several local and online vendors.
- Costs: Sailors pay a fee each season (fall and spring) directly to Chicago Yacht Club (via CYC website) which covers boats and facilities, coaching, insurance, etc. In 2016, this was \$550 your first season, \$750 after that, but CYC Members pay \$500. Financial assistance may be available.
- There are also SICP team dues, which cover MISSA membership, team social events, and other costs. These are \$100/year. CYC membership available for either student or family. Joining as a junior member is about \$75 and then \$25/month. Strongly recommended for Varsity sailors.
- In addition, for Varsity/JV sailors attending regattas, there will be a registration fee for each regatta (typically about \$30), plus a share of the travel costs for sailors and coaches.
