

Class of 2018

Last month, senior students received the following message from IT regarding the upcoming deactivation of their Ignatius network and email accounts:

"In accordance with our technology policy, and as part of our process to close the 2017-2018 school year, we will be deactivating your Saint Ignatius student email and Google Apps account on Friday, June 15, at 12:00 p.m.

Once your account is deactivated, you will lose access to your student email and any data that you have stored in the Saint Ignatius Google Apps virtual storage space. You should backup or download any data that you need prior to this date. The steps to back up your data are below. If you need assistance doing this, stop by the student help desk before June 15. Be sure to allow enough time to back up your data as the process can take several days depending on what you choose to backup.

Special Note for Summer College Communications: If you are using your Saint Ignatius email address for any college communications, please be sure to change the email address to a personal email address for any communications that need to take place after June 15."

All Classes: Annual Medication Forms

Please note that medication forms need to be **updated annually**. Acetaminophen, ibuprofen and cough drops are stocked in the Nurse's Office. Medication will only be given to students who have **parent and physician signatures** on the [medication form dated for the 2018-2019 school year](#) and on file in the Nurse's Office. Completed forms may be dropped off at the main entrance during the summer or in the Deans' Office once school resumes in August.

Class of 2019

Illinois Law requires all students entering the twelfth grade to show proof of having received two doses of meningococcal conjugate vaccination (MCV). This information must be submitted to the Nurse's Office by August 1, 2018.
